The specific purpose of the Apprentice Lineman is to provide for a planned program of progressive training and experiences that will result in the development of skills and knowledge necessary for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a reliable electric system. Initially, the successful candidate will be classified as a Groundman 0-12 months and then converted to a 1st Year Apprentice Lineman after successfully gaining experience in the Groundman position for six months.

Required Education Degrees, Certificates, and/or Licenses:

High school diploma or equivalent. Must have the ability to operate a motor vehicle and possess a valid New Mexico driver's license and CDL Class A driver's license. Must be eligible to be and remain insured as a driver by the Cooperative's group liability policy for the automotive fleet.

Essential Functions/Job Duties: Responds to service calls to restore power. Performs stand-by duties for power restoration and associated problems during and after normal working hours, and on holidays and weekends. Complies with all the Cooperative's safety rules and uses safe work practices. Acquires a thorough working knowledge of first aid and pole top rescue. Complies with all traffic laws, rules and regulations while operating Cooperative vehicles; and meets all state requirements such as CDL license or any other qualifications necessary. Acquires and/or maintains a working knowledge of all substation switching operations, system apparatus or devices as per qualified training. Acquire a working knowledge of JMEC and RUS specifications, the National Electric Safety Code, OSHA and JMEC mapping systems and staking sheets. Gain a working knowledge of the Cooperative and line department policies and procedures. Attend applicable safety meetings and other special training sessions when requested. Comply with the proper operating practices in the use of the two-way radio. Ensure that Cooperative tools, equipment, and material are properly maintained and stored securely. Report all property damages. Recommend to supervisor or Working Foreman where improvements can be made in operations, practices, procedures, and methods. Promote and present a positive professional image when performing his/her duties.

Job Requirements and Experience:

The Groundman 0-12 months to Apprentice Lineman will not work within contact distance of an energized conductor on a pole while in this position. Work will be limited to construction and maintenance, in which poles are completely de-energized and grounded. By the end of the first year, the individual must have demonstrated the abilities to work effectively and have practical knowledge in the following areas: Cooperative safety rules, first aid training, identification and proper use of material, tools, and equipment, frame poles, RUS specifications and basic construction units, climbing poles, drive and inspection before operating vehicles, and

equipment. Operate radio and meet all state requirements to operate JMEC vehicles such as CDL license or any other qualifications.
